

A look at God throughout the Old Testament Visions and Appearances

All visions of God in Heaven are indicated by the arrows. All others listed below are appearances by Theophanies (angel form, Heb. 2:16). It is interesting to note that ALL of these *vision* speak of God as being absolutely One, with only one "divine being" revealed as God. And Daniel's vision, although speaking of the "Son of man," (7:13) does NOT reveal two *divine* beings! Only ONE Deity! The "Son of man" approaches the "Ancient of days." This vision is repeated some 4 times in this chapter. The "Son of man" only being mentioned once! This is of course, speaking of a future time during or *after* the 4th Beast or kingdoms reign. (See Chart 2)

4. Isa 6:1 I saw also the LORD sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the Temple.

5. Eze 1:26- 2:1 And upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man upon it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw *it*, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake. And he said unto me, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee.

6. Dan 7:9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, (See Chart 2)

1. Job 1:6 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.

Job 2:1 Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them to present himself before the LORD.

2. Gen 28:13 And behold the LORD stood above it, and said, I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac:

3. 1 Kings 22:19; 2 Chron 18:18

I saw the LORD sitting on his throne, and all the host of heaven standing by him on his right hand and on his left.
